These are all kept up to date on the website, but depending on your computer, you may need to refresh the browser on the selected syllabus page or clear your cache to make sure you are looking at the most recent update to our website. Theory: Please note that in theory grades 1-4, the versions of the memory tunes given in the theory syllabus are only versions accepted.
